2023 COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT REPORT

MRFEC began 2023 with enthusiasm and high expectations but it became apparent that with high employment rates post covid, we experienced a fall in enrolments for our traditional ACFE job preparation courses. The competition from various organisations such government funded free TAFE, offering some of our regular courses for very low or no fees, had a significant impact on our budget, and our course provisions.

Our Neighbourhood house courses, both short, and long, and our one-off events, were slow to build during early 2023. Again possibly due to post covid hesitancy. I'm happy to say they are now attracting healthy numbers and increasing enrolments.

Our tutors provide the learning and connection for our students, and feedback from classes is always excellent.

We have partnered with other local neighbourhood houses to provide appropriate and interest-based courses to the wider Macedon Ranges Community. We value those partnerships and appreciate other groups willingness to share and host our courses at their venues.

The Committee of Management have developed a new Strategic Plan to guide the centre through 2023-2027.

The MRFEC Committee was sad to say farewell and thank you to Vice President Pauline Tarrant who served the organisation so well. Pauline gave over 20 years of service to MRFEC Committee of Management team in serving our Macedon Ranges community. We also thanked John Tikulin our Gisborne Secondary College representative, who took up a new teaching position out of the area. John was with us for over three years. We look forward to the new representative from Gisborne Secondary College.

The Centre leadership has also undergone some changes. Manager Monica Smyrek who led the admin team through Covid, left mid-year and was replaced by Rebecca Harris. Regretfully Rebecca left us, and the Committee is currently recruiting a new Co-Ordinator for the centre.

Our admin team and the volunteers continue to provide a welcoming and professional environment for all who tutor and attend our classes and events.

An update of our Website is progressing, and our social media presence is proving to be a valuable tool to inform and keep up to date communication, with current and prospective students.

On behalf of the Committee of Management I wish to thank our staff and volunteers that work hard to enable MRFEC to continue in its role to support our local community. I would encourage others with similar community values to inquire at the office and consider joining our committee team.

A special thanks to our volunteers over the year who assist us in reception and other tasks. All have been a welcome addition to our small and friendly team. Thank you to **Diane Harle**, **John Haydock** and **Lindy Chapman**.

Successes during 2023 include;

- Purchased new kiln from grant received in 2022.
- Received a grant from Foundation for Rural & Regional Renewal to replace furniture in fover area.
- Received funding support from Macedon Ranges Shire Council to support our Economic Development projects and activities.
- Transition from VETtrak to Social Planet.
- Participated in the Rotary Volunteer Expo.
- Conducted an Open Day during Adult Learners Week during Gisborne's Market Day.
- Submitting monthly articles in Gisborne Gazette to gain further community awareness.
- Partnered with PS My Family Matters to deliver monthly walks and morning teas (supported by Neighbourhood Houses Victoria) to support local carers in the area.
- Partnered with Woodend Neighbourhood House and Goonawarra Neighbourhood House to run Floristry, Pottery and Barista classes.
- Continued our partnership with Macedon & Mt Macedon Community House in running Permaculture courses via an MOU.
- Partnered with Deakin University Student Freelancing Hub to conduct a project on Community Engagement
- Employer Engagement Steering Committee completed the Employer Engagement Consultation via surveying local employers and youth.

We look forward to 2024 and growing the programs and community engagement at Macedon Ranges Further Education Centre.
